
# Possible products along corridors

Corridors	Possible Product
Thimphu - Phuentsholing - Jaigaon - Chenggrabandha - Burimari - Dhaka	
Kathmandu – Kakarvitta – Phulbari- Banglaband – Dhaka	Import from Bangladesh to Nepal: <b>Fabric</b>

## Possible factors for consideration in identifying the products:

- ▶ Volume of trade
- ▶ Importance of product for GDP, farmers and SMEs
- ▶ Contribution to employment
- ▶ Frequency of shipments
- ▶ Whether products are identified as high-potential/strategic products
- ▶ Whether trade process includes common (or many) bottlenecks/high number of agencies/inefficient procedures
- ▶ Value of trade

TTFMM implementation team leader	a senior member of NTTFC, or a person appointed by NTTFC, or a person appointed by the competent ministry	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(1) Political support;</li> <li>(2) Help coordinate with concerned NTTFC members incl. various gov. depts., agencies and private sector, if necessary</li> </ul>
TTFMM implementation coordinator	NTTFC Secretariat, or any suitable team appointed	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(1) Oversee the TTFMM implementation;</li> <li>(2) Select and guide study team(s) to conduct relevant studies;</li> <li>(3) Coordinate with concerned NTTFC members incl. various gov. depts., agencies and private sector;</li> <li>(4) Maintain TTFMM database;</li> <li>(5) Facilitate publishing TTFMM report including dissemination of key findings to policy makers and relevant stakeholders</li> </ul>

	Candidates	Possible Responsibilities
Team members to collect BPA data & undertake TTFMM analysis, develop database and prepare TTFMM report	A Bangladesh research institute	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(1) Undertake BPA study;</li> <li>(2) Provide technical support to TRS team;</li> <li>(3) Work with TCD team to collect data (incl. preparing the data collection form);</li> <li>(4) Undertake overall TTFMM analysis including comparing data collected through BPA, TRS and TCD and preparing report;</li> <li>(5) Input data and develop TTFMM database; and</li> <li>(6) Organize consultation/data verification meeting if necessary</li> </ol>
Team members to collect TRS data	Bangladesh Customs	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(1) Prepare TRS data collection form in consultation with other team members; and</li> <li>(2) collect TRS data</li> </ol>
Team members to collect TCD data	Freight forwarders Association and partners	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(1) Distribute data collection form to drivers/ participating trucking companies and explain how to fill in the form; [drivers collect data by filling in the forms]</li> <li>(2) Collect filled-in data collection from the drivers;</li> <li>(3) Pass the completed forms to BPA study team for analysis</li> </ol>
