





- Grant US\$ 15 million, released in two tranches upon completion of policy actions.

 - Establishment of the pilot NSW
 - Trade/Customs portal





JFPR TA Support

- 4 TA s (1 REG, 3 national for NEP, BAN and BHU; \$
 1.5 million each), approved in August/September

 2013, closing in July/August 2016.
- Accession to the RKC as a Project Output Target
- Low disbursement 6 % disbursed, 12 % contract awarded as of March 2015 (NEP).
