## Good Afternoon,

- It is my immense pleasure to deliver a few works in this Inception Meeting for the SASEC Customs Reform and Modernization for Trade Facilitation Program jointly organized by the Department of Customs and the Asian Development Bank.
- 2. The government of Nepal and the ADB has a long history of cooperation. The first technical assistance was received on 1996 to introduce ASYCUDA in Customs, which was a great leap forward in Customs automation at that time. ADB has also assisted Customs in 2007 and 2013 through different assistance. These all assistances ware well perceived and successful.

- 6. In this context, I believe that this will be an excellent step to fulfill our commitments to the Trade Facilitation Agreement of the World Trade Organization as well as related international standards on customs.
- 7. We can see prominent personalities in the program. This is a rear event for us. This has encouraged us to move forward in our mission. I take this opportunity to welcome our respected Santaraj sir, Rajan sir, Chadra sir and Sishir sir to be presented in todays program. I also welcome Mr. Ronald Antinio Butiong and Ms. Sonoko Sunayama for their taking trouble to come and join this event from Manila. I welcome Mr. Sharad Bhadari ji for the participation.
