# ADB, Bangladesh Sign Deal for SASEC Dhaka-Northwest Corridor

#### 20 June 2025: Dhaka, Bangladesh

The Asian Development Bank (ADB) and the Government of Bangladesh signed a loan agreement to upgrade the Second South Asia Subregional Economic Cooperation (SASEC) Dhaka-Northwest Corridor Road Project. The agreement is for a \$204 million loan, which is the fourth tranche of a \$1.2 billion multitranche assistance for the international trade corridor.

## **Bangladesh Launches Fully Automated Trade Clearance System**

#### 1 July 2025: Dhaka, Bangladesh

The Government of Bangladesh has launched a fully automated trade clearance system, making the submission and issuance of Certificates, Licenses, and Permits for import and export mandatory through the Bangladesh Single Window platform starting 1 July 2025. This digital platform, developed by the National Board of Revenue, allows businesses to apply for and receive all necessary documents from 19 major government agencies online, eliminating the need for manual processing.

The 25-foot structure built using steel and wood-plastic composite materials features smart technology and sustainable design. It is packed with features aimed at streamlining both travel and trade.

# Nepal Begins Export of Electricity to Bangladesh via India's Electricity Grid

#### 15 June 2025: Kathmandu, Nepal

Nepal began its regular export of electricity to Bangladesh, by sending 40 MW of electricity through India's power grid on 15 June 2025. According to the landmark trilateral agreement between the Nepal Electricity Authority, Bangladesh Power Development Board, and India's NTPC Vidyut Vyapar Nigam, signed in October 2024, Nepal will supply electricity to Bangladesh from 15 June to 15 November for five years.

## Reliance Power and Bhutan Forge Landmark Solar Energy Partnership

#### 19 May 2025: Bengaluru India

Reliance Power of India has signed a major agreement with Green Digital Private Limited, a Bhutan government-owned entity, to develop Bhutan's largest solar energy project. The initiative, valued at Rs2,000 crore (around \$234 million), will generate 500 MW of electricity. This project builds on a partnership between Reliance Enterprises and Druk Holding and Investments for the 770-MW Chamkharchhu-I hydropower project.

## India and Maldives sign 13 MoUs to Enhance Ferry Services

#### 18 May 2025: New Delhi, India

India and Maldives signed 13 new memorandums of understanding aimed at enhancing ferry services across the island nation. Backed by a grant of MVR100 million (approximately \$6.6 million) under the third phase of the High Impact Community Development Project, these agreements aim to improve maritime connectivity, transport infrastructure, and community livelihoods in Maldives.
