ADB Study Explores Potential of Bangladesh–India Rail-based Cargo

4 July 2023: Dhaka, Bangladesh

An ADB study, under the SASEC Program, is exploring the potential of rail-based cargo movement between India and Bangladesh, noted the Business Standard. The study aims to (i) identify infrastructure gaps, (ii) propose technologybased solutions for cargo and container movement, (iii) recommend regulatory reforms to facilitate freight train operations between the two countries, and (iv) explore the potential for transit cargo to and from Nepal and Bhutan.

Bangladesh Railways plans to install an elephant warning system along its new rail tracks that can serve as an early warning measure for slowing or stopping the trains along the new Dohazari-Cox's Bazar Railway route in Bangladesh. The route will pass through three forests that are the habitat of elephants. The railway project is being funded by ADB under the SASEC Program.

Bhutan, India Foreign Secretaries Chair the India-Bhutan **Development Cooperation Talks, Inaugurate Projects**

29 July 2023: New Delhi, India

Ms. Aum Pema Choden, Foreign Secretary of the Government of Bhutan, and Mr. Vinay Kwatra, Foreign Secretary of the Government of India, co-chaired the India-Bhutan Development Cooperation Talks, discussed matters of mutual interest, and inaugurated several projects that were implemented with the assistance of India, including the National Single Window portal, during Ms. Choden's official visit to India. They also discussed Bhutan's 13th Five Year Plan, with India expressing its commitment to partner with Bhutan based on the priorities of the government and people of Bhutan and advance their bilateral partnership.

22 July 2023: New Delhi, India

The fourth meeting of experts from India and Nepal on the Pancheshwar Multipurpose Project have agreed to move forward and finalize the Detailed Project Report of the 6,480 megawatt project in Nepal. The project is part of the Mahakali treaty signed in February 1996. It aims to generate power, provide irrigation, and mitigate flooding.

21 July 2023: New Delhi, India

India Prime Minister Narendra Modi extended a warm welcome to Sri Lanka President Ranil Wickremesinghe during his visit to India in July 2023. Speaking at the joint press meet by the two country leaders, Prime Minister Modi reiterated that India stands alongside Sri Lanka. The two leaders adopted a vision document for the two countries' economic partnership that emphasizes India's long-term commitment to Sri Lanka. The partnership envisages deepening connectivity and cooperation in various sectors, including tourism, trade, and energy.

17 July 2023: New Delhi, India

The Government of India plans to develop the Eastern Grid waterway with 5,000 kms of navigable waterways, according to Mr. Sarbananda Sonowal, Minister of Ports, Shipping and Waterways. The Eastern Grid can potentially unlock multilateral trade worth \$49 billion, boost regional integration, and accelerate development.

Second Section of India-Nepal Cross-border Rail Starts to Operate

16 July 2023: Kathmandu, Nepal

The second phase of the Jaynagar (India)-Bijalpura (Nepal)-Bardibas (Nepal) cross-border rail line project, the Kurtha-Bijalpura rail section, became operational on 16 July 2023. The rail section covers a total of 17.3 km. A total of five stations are found on this route-Kurtha, Pipradi, Loharpatti, Singyahi, and Bijalpura.

Bangladesh and Nepal Agree on Long-term Power Trade

9 July 2023: Kathmandu, Nepal

The Governments of Bangladesh and Nepal have agreed to sign a long-term power sale agreement that will run for 25 years, according to Mr. Kul Man Ghising, Managing Director of the Nepal Electricity Authority. The Bangladesh Power Development Board (BPDB), NTPC Vidyut Vyapar Nigam Limited of India, and the Nepal Electricity Authority (NEA), are set to sign a tripartite agreement allowing the export of power from Nepal to Bangladesh using Indian territory. Upon signing of this agreement, the understanding between Bangladesh and Nepal will be formalized.
